



Invitation for Bids (IFB) No. 20-07 for Exterior Painting of the METRO Maintenance Building

Santa Cruz Metropolitan Transit District (Santa Cruz METRO) has issued IFB No. 20-07 for Exterior Painting of the METRO Maintenance Building, due at 2:00 P.M. on March 10, 2020. Bidders must submit all Documents included in the Bid Form (Part II), fully completed, dated and executed, along with any required information identified in the Specifications (Part VII) of the IFB. A contract will be executed in substantially the same form as the sample contract provided in Part V of the IFB.

Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) as defined in 49 CFR Part 23 shall have the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of the contract with Santa Cruz METRO, and all contractors shall take all necessary and reasonable steps to ensure that Disadvantaged Business Enterprises have the maximum opportunity to compete for and perform contracts and subcontracts.

In connection with the execution of any contract with Santa Cruz METRO, the successful contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or application for employment because of race, color, ancestry, national origin, religion, sex, sexual preference, marital status, age, medical condition or disability.

Santa Cruz METRO, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-Assisted Programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all contractors that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit a bid in response to this Invitation for Bids and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Contractors and subcontractors must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 at the time of bid. (See Labor Code section 1771.1(a).) This Contract is subject to monitoring and enforcement by the DIR pursuant to Labor Code Section 1771.4.
