Santa Cruz METRO Announces Free Fares to the Santa Cruz County Fair METRO Riders Also Receive Discount Fair Tickets September 10-14, 2025

Santa Cruz, CA (Wednesday, August 27, 2025) - The Santa Cruz Metropolitan Transit District (METRO) announces free fares on both fixed-route and ParaCruz services to the Santa Cruz County Fair hosted at the Watsonville Fairgrounds, September 10-14th.

Fairgoers can look forward to classic favorites returning this year, including the Tractor Parade, Horse Show, and Charras, alongside thrilling new attractions like FMX Ramp-Age, featuring X Games Gold Medalist Adam Jones, Pro Wrestling Revolution, and the bilingual It's Showtime Circus.

To make getting to the Fair easier than ever, METRO has launched a special weekday route - Route 79F, offering free service directly to the fairgrounds. Weekend fixed-route riders can also take advantage of free rides on Route 79, which will serve the fairgrounds on September 10-14. ParaCruz customers will enjoy free daily service throughout the fair.

Riders who take Routes 79F, 79 or ParaCruz service to the Fair will also receive discounted County Fair tickets. To obtain the discount, riders should request a coupon voucher from the operator and present the voucher at the fair ticketing window when purchasing tickets; \$7 discount for adults, and \$6 discount for youth (age 6-12).



Service will depart from the Watsonville Transit Center at :35 past the

hour from 10:35am - 9:35pm on weekdays, and 8:35am - 9:35pm on weekends. Return trips from the County Fair will depart on the hour from 11:00am - 10:00pm on weekdays, and 9:00am - 10:00pm on weekends.
